b)	Learning Outcomes for JSRCC students	The benefits that you hope your students will accomplish by participating in the program. Include the way in which you plan to relate the information learned through the program with the material covered in class.
c)	Budget	Itemize the funds requested, being specific and providing documentation to support your budget. Include in-kind support if appropriate.
d)	Evaluation/Assessment Measures	How you plan to evaluate the effectiveness or learning outcomes of the program.

Note: Proposals will be reviewed by the Student Life Committee. Funding is awarded on a first-come, first-serve basis. Partial grants may be awarded depending on the volume of submissions and the amount of available funding.
