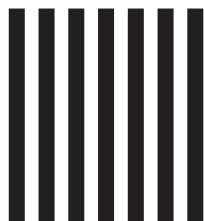

With an active regional coalition from collision centers, insurance companies and related industries supporting the program, this two-year Associate in Applied Science (A.A.S.) degree combines classroom and laboratory instruction with paid and supervised on-the-job training in the region's top body shops. First-year classes are held during the day on JSRCC's Western Campus in Goochland County, just 30 minutes from downtown Richmond. In the second year, most classes are held during the afternoon and evening hours at Chesterfield Technical Center in the Collision Repair laboratory.
