Course Title: ALS Field Internship II

Course Description: Continues with the second in a series of field experiences providing supervised direct patient care in out-of-hospital advanced life support units. Laboratory 3 hours per week.

General Course Purpose: Provides supervised direct patient contact on out-of-hospital advanced life support units.

Course Objectives:

Upon completing the course, the student will be able to

- a. Complete the minimum hour requirements for the Paramedic curricula as established by the Commonwealth of Virginia Manpower and Training Committee and the Department of Transportation, for the field internship;
- b. Complete 50 precept calls on an ALS unit;
- c. Complete all remaining patient assessments from all three patient age ranges, pediatric, adult, and geriatric;
- d. Complete all remaining skills, to include IV, intubation, and ventilation;
- e. Successfully pass the National Registry-Paramedic Written Exam; and
- f. Successfully pass all practical stations of the National Registry Paramedic Exam.
