1. COURSE PREFIX and NUMBER: **HMS 258** CREDIT HOURS: 3

2. COURSE TITLE: **Case Management and Substance Abuse**

3. PREREQUISITES: None

4. COURSE DESCRIPTION: Focuses on the process for interviewing substance abuse clients. Includes intake, assessment, handling denial, and ending the interview. Teaches skills for writing short-term goals and treatment plans with emphasis on accountability. Examines various reporting devices. Lecture 3 hours per week.

6. GENERAL COURSE OBJECTIVES:

Upon successful completion of the course, the student will be able to:

- b. Understand the relationship between managed case and case management of substance abuse treatment.
- c. Cite ways of accessing additional community resources through case management to meet the needs of methadone clients.
- d. Describe a strengths based model of case management/advocacy: adapting a mental health model to practice work with persons who have substance abuse problems.
- e. Describe case management using a community-based service model of drug intervention.
