The College is seeking applicants for the position of Mathematics Instructor. This position will be assigned to the School of Mathematics and Science, located on the Parham Road Campus, 1651 E. Parham Road.

TYPE OF APPOINTMENT	Full-time nine-month teaching faculty-ranked appointment. Salary commensurate with the education and experience of the applicant. Salary range: \$40,061 - \$85,810. Approximate maximum hiring salary: \$49,707.
QUALIFICATIONS REQUIRED	Master's degree in Mathematics; or Master's with 18 graduate semester hours in Mathematics. The selected candidate must be able to successfully pass the college's pre-employment security screening.
QUALIFICATIONS PREFERRED	Related occupational experience or teaching experience in one or more college level courses including developmental, occupational-technical, and university-college transfer. Wide range of coursework and/or teaching experience throughout mathematical subject areas. Demonstrated experience in curriculum development. Demonstrated experience in a Computer Enhanced Modularized Developmental Mathematics program. Demonstrated ability to work with diverse student populations. Demonstrated ability to incorporate technology routinely into instructional and faculty responsibilities. Demonstrated strong written and oral communication skills.
POSITION RESPONSIBILITIES:	The primary responsibility is teaching. Faculty hired in this position will be required to teach courses in the following areas: transfer, non-transfer and developmental. Faculty loads are normally scheduled on an average of fifteen (15) credit hours per semester. Office hours, advising and collateral duty assignments are maintained. Teaching schedules may include day and evening classes and multiple campus and off-campus assignments. Opportunities for summer teaching will be based on student interest.
