The position will be assigned to the School of Mathematics, Science and Engineering, located on the Downtown Campus, 700 East Jackson Street.

TYPE OF APPOINTMENT: Full-time nine-month teaching faculty-ranked appointment. Salary commensurate with the education and experience of the applicant. Salary range: \$31,876 - \$102,279. Approximate maximum hiring salary: \$62,000.

QUALIFICATIONS REQUIRED: Master's degree in Computer Science; or Master's degree in any field but must include eighteen (18) graduate semester hours in Computer Science. The selected candidate must be able to pass the college's pre-employment security screening.

QUALIFICATIONS PREFERRED: Progressive and recent experience programming or teaching one or more object oriented programming languages such as Java. Progressive and recent software development experience. Experience in Java/JEE development, software engineering and problem solving. Experience in User Interface design; and, user experience (UI/UX Design). Experience with Java Swing / JavaFX / Rich Client Platforms (such as NetBeans, Eclipse, Flash/Flex). Experience with WebLogic and Unix. Experience with Eclipse, Subversion (SVN), Apache Ant, Gradle, Spring, REST web services. Experience or familiarity with Oracle and Hibernate. Ability to quickly become proficient in new technologies. Teaching experience in computer science at the community college level. Demonstrated experience in curriculum development for face-to-face courses and distance learning instruction. Demonstrated ability to utilize various and multiple teaching strategies to create student-centered classrooms. Demonstrated ability to communicate effectively, orally and in writing. Demonstrated ability to work with a diverse population of faculty, staff and students.

POSITION RESPONSIBILITIES: The primary responsibility is teaching. Faculty hired in this position will be required to teach courses in the transfer and non-transfer areas. Faculty loads are normally scheduled on an average of fifteen (15) credit hours per semester. Office hours, advising and collateral duty assignments are maintained. Teaching schedules may include day and evening classes and multiple campus and off-campus assignments. Opportunities for summer teaching will be based on student interest.
