**Virginia Governor Terry McAuliffe to deliver address at  
Reynolds 43rd Commencement**

**RICHMOND, Va. (April 19, 2016)** – Virginia Governor Terry McAuliffe will deliver the commencement speech at Reynolds Community College's 43rd Commencement, which will be held on Sunday, May 15, at 2 p.m. at the Virginia Commonwealth University Stuart C. Siegel Center, located at 1200 West Broad Street in Richmond.

During Governor McAuliffe's 27 months in office, he has made 641 economic development announcements bringing \$10.95 billion in capital investments to the Commonwealth, won bipartisan support for investing \$1 billion in new funds for education at all levels and led Virginia to become the first state to functionally end veteran homelessness.

Serving more than 19,000 students annually, Reynolds is the youngest and third largest of 23 community colleges in Virginia. Reynolds operates three campuses serving residents in the City of Richmond and the counties of Henrico, Hanover, Goochland, Powhatan and Louisa.

Reynolds has one formal commencement ceremony each year after the spring semester for students completing certificate or Associate Degree curricula throughout the academic year.
